INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS

Meals are \$12 per meal, billed quarterly at 13 meals for \$156 (for a total of \$624.00 per year).

Pancake Day: Each member is responsible for \$75 worth of tickets and will be billed for them upon receiving them in December or January. Sell the tickets and your account will be credited the \$75.

New Member Fees (ONE TIME fee):

- Meals are billed quarterly (Oct., Jan., April, & July)
- Dues are billed once, although you may pay quarterly if you set this up with the treasurer. (Jean Obenour: 740-387-3788 or jean@customaccounting.com)
- Active members have to pay for their meals whether they attend the meetings or not and are billed a quarter in **advance**.

Kiwanis International charges us dues for any member **on the roster in October**. So, if a member should resign in Nov. or Dec., (and hadn't paid their dues) we will have to ask for the member to reimburse the club for this cost.

ORGANIZATIONAL (i.e., Corporate or Non-Profit) MEMBERS:

“Corporate Members” must have 25 or more employees.

Dues: Dues cover International dues, District dues, Club dues, Kiwanis Magazine, and club liability insurance. \$135 for the first member. The first member will be the “corporate member” for Kiwanis International purposes and may be switched by the corporation with no additional New Member Fee if the original person leaves the company. \$135 for the second member. This member will be an individual member with full membership privileges but the dues will be paid by the organization. \$30 for the third member. This member will be an individual member with full membership privileges but the dues will be paid by the organization. Maximum of 3 members per organization. 300/year flat for maximum of 3 individuals from the organization ()

Meals: \$12/person: charged only if a person attends a meeting (but minimum of \$12 per month). Examples: If all three of the organization’s individuals attend a single meeting, the organization will be charged \$36; If only one individual attends a particular meeting, \$12 will be assessed; If no one attends a particular meeting, \$0 will be assessed; There is, however, a \$12/month minimum.
